Commissioner Scirocco stated this is a new position that will be responsible for coordinating activities such as maintaining daily logs, payment of accounts for a variety of things at the garage, coordinating and installation of new fleet management system, and answering incoming calls,

<u>Discussion and Vote: Authorization for Mayor to Sign Change Order #4 with Collett Mechanical, Inc. for City Hall Renovation – HVAC</u>

Commissioner Scirocco advised this change order includes a microprocessor energy based control that reduces the amount of energy needed to run the heat and air conditioning. A non-functioning radiator was cut, capped, and removed from the DPW office area.

<u>Discussion and Vote: Authorization for Mayor to Sign Change Order #5 with Collett Mechanical, Inc. for City Hall Renovation – Plumbing</u>

Commissioner Scirocco advised this change order is for the relocation of a fire sprinkler in the basement and removal of a sump pump.

<u>Discussion and Vote: Authorization for Mayor to Sign Change Order #7 with DLC Electric, LLC for City Hall Renovation – Electric</u>

Commissioner Scirocco advised this is for the installation of wiring in the City Council Room.

Commissioner Scirocco stated this change order is in the amount of \$168,121.42 for unforeseen conditions and changes to the original scope of work.

Commissioner Scirocco advised this is for the continuation of restoration efforts at the Casino. This project includes the parlor cupolas.
