

Recreation Department Directors Report- January 28, 2020

The monthly Director's report is designed to update you on the activities the Recreation Department is working on.

1. Recreation Center Update: After meeting with DPW the timeline was extended and the new estimated date that the Gym will be reopened is June 1st. This date includes estimated time for moving staff and supplies and resurfacing the gym floor. If we can wait until after camp to resurface the gym floor we will.
2. As the fiscal year comes to a close and we collect the remaining 2019 fees from December rentals the Department will begin working on the Annual Report. We plan to present the Annual Report to the Recreation Commission at the March meeting.
3. We are working on offering two new summer camp programs. The first will be a cooking camp with I am A Chef Too and the second will be a Sports Camp. We haven't selected the vendor for the Sports camp. Both of these would be full day camps but they will not be included with our Camp Saradac program. These would be stand alone camps, not requiring the Department of Health Permit.
4. The Department will be partnering with the City's Administrator of Parks, Open Lands, Historic Preservation, and Sustainability and the Department of Public Safety to host a Bike Rodeo in May or June at the Recreation Center. The Free event will focus on bike safety and include bike maintenance and helmet give-a-ways.
