The director's report is designed to provide a monthly overview of Recreation Department's work.

1. Staffing: We are pleased to announce Brandon Butts has officially accepted the full time program coordinator position effective February 22nd.
2. Spring Programs: Spring registration is going well. Included programs this spring are: soccer program and league, teeball & jr sluggers clinics, volleyball, intro to ice skating, boxing, and bowling. We also added a pickleball workshop during February vacation week.
3. Youth Basketball League: Our youth basketball league ended February 12th. This year was a challenge with the number of cancellations and the limited number of refs, players, and coaches but overall we seemed to have a great season.
4. Skate Park: The project has been postponed to 2023. The construction company is booked for 2022.
5. Rec Center Parking Lot: DPW is looking to begin the week of February 22. The initial phase will include clear cutting the area. Once I have details on the layout of the parking lot I will share them with the Commission.
6. Camp Saradac: Camp registration opens February 28th for City Residents and March 21st for Non City Residents.
